* Liz Capron will do a power point show during the banquet.

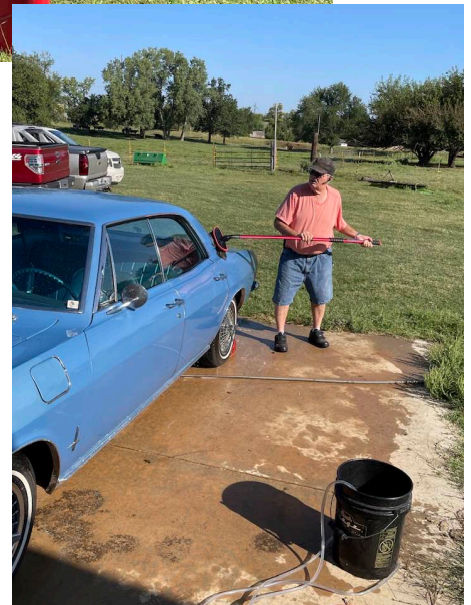
* Colleen Law will do a cheat sheet with restaurant information and a FAQ sheet.

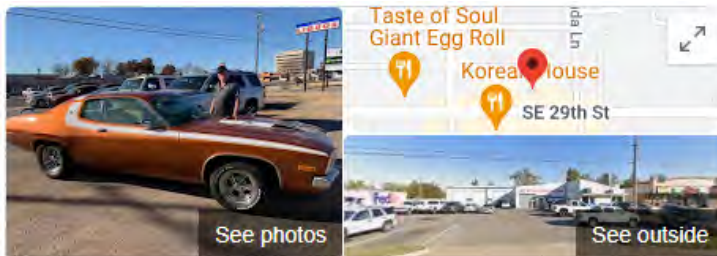

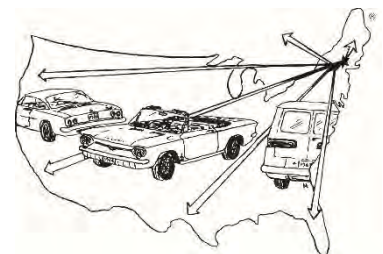
