
I also want to know more about your cars, such as equipment, whether it's drivable and what you like or dislike about your car.

### COCA Minutes January 27, 2024

Jim Gailey gave a short acceptance speech.


Scott Law made a motion to adjourn the meeting, this was seconded by Pat Silver and approved by the membership.

## Bob's Tech Corner

Hey COCA members and fellow Corvair enthusiasts. I have been absent a few months fighting some Corvair related issues. ROTISERATING my 65 Turbo convertible! Sorry about that! This month I have put together a short Chart that many of us may be familiar with, regarding the wrench size we need for the fastener we are using!

For example: We all know or should know that if you need a 3/4" wrench (for your 3/4" lug nut), you can substitute a 19mm. If you don't remember, the wheel studs are 1/2"x20. The threads will not change the size wrench needed, however.

The following chart is a quick reference. My hope is that everyone will find it helpful

Bolt SIZE and S	Socket or wrench size need	ded
Fastener	Socket/Wrench	Metric
1/8	5/16	8mm
3/16	3/8	10mm
1/4	7/16	11mm
5/16	1/2	13mm


