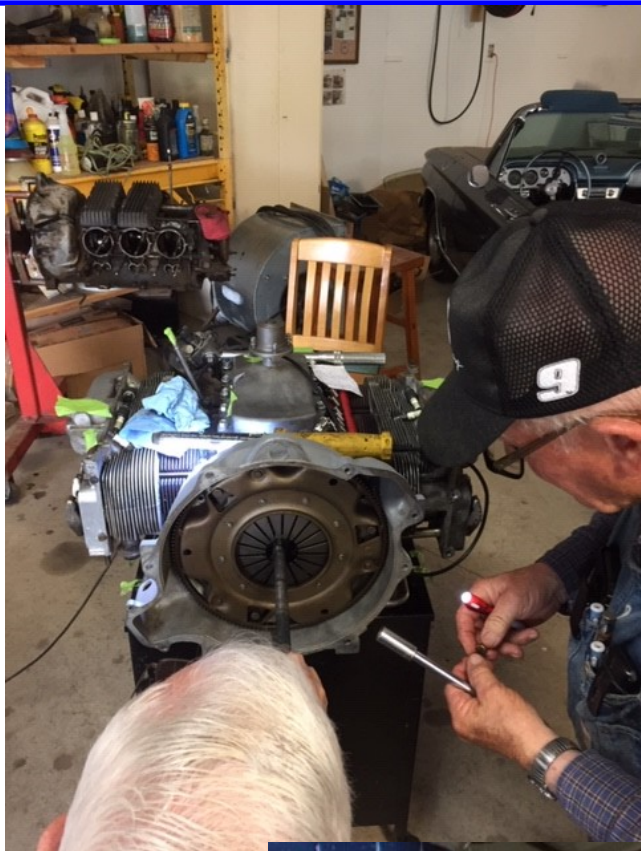
Don't forget coffee at Ken's Sunday and Wednesday mornings.

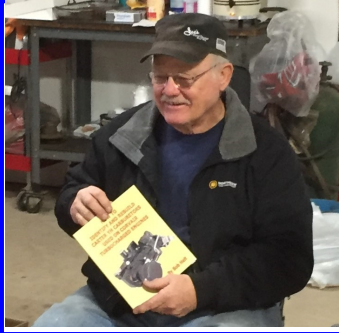

Bob's Tech Corner

Here we are in the middle of JUNE and the weather is not cooperating with us. We all are trying to finish up our winter projects and or help other members to finish theirs.

On that thought.....

I have been working on Janny's '66 Corsa for almost a year now. Stepping back and looking at the process, my observation on this rescue / rebuild is this... Although I am NO Purest (by any stretch of the imagination), I find myself falling or should I say leaning toward many aspects of stock configuration.

So the reason for this Rescue to a true Corvair configuration.

This 66 Corsa was an 1980s INCA club member's car and was in the process of having a Tornado V8 installed, when I saw it in the 90s!

After many years of it sitting and only partially being "done", I had the opportunity to see it at the shop of the builder. I had loaned him a collection of articles many years before (around 1985) so he could research the Tornado swap. I finally contacted the borrower to retrieve my collection of articles.

Showing me the project car, and describing the work that had been done, I found that it was the same, beautiful, 66 Regal Red Corsa, that I had admired when the owner would drive it to club events some years before!

Now.... some of the work included a disc brake front end (S10 Spindles Rotors and Calipers) and the rear suspension had been removed. New, Toro rear control arms had been fabricated. And there it sat... for many more years. Fast forward to 2018 and I had the opportunity to meet a young man named Tony Imig. He had inherited the car and wanted to sell it and a 67 Monza that was located in his garage.

I purchased both cars. Pat Silver offered his trailer to help move the 66 to my house and so the work began.....

Tony helped me move the 67.

The first thing I had to do was to sell the 67. Done! Thanks to Jim Hunter the 67 found a great home. The next thing was to procure the missing pieces of the firewall in preparation to restore the Corvair power train. Tony had tried to cut out the needed pieces but they were too small so..... a trip to the Juna Tuna 2018, at the Kalp shop in Wichita, KS. was in order. Terry pointed me in the direction of a derelict 67 and provided me the power tools to remove all of the firewall I needed. THANKS Terry! Next was preping the car 's sheet metal to accept the "new" firewall panel. Actually the "new" panel had to be massaged as well so as to mate the panel into the hole that was left when the PO's "builder" cut it out to install the TORO drivetrain. As you will see, this was no a straight forward process.



The good thing was, that the brake lines were left in tact, so that was one problem that was easily resolved.

Replacing the firewall and package area had to be done in 3 separate operations. This was necessary so that they could be better fitted and welded in without interference from the other panels. I had to remove some of the old package area in order to weld it in separately. it actually took TWO rear panels to restore the firewall/package area sufficiently! Below, is the upper part of the package area next to the rear window. the spot welds were removed in order to fit it with the lower firewall panel correctly.



Fitting and cutting and fitting again to get the best fit could be before welding. I used CLICOs to hold everything together ! Yes the BFH is there for a reason!



This was just a trial fitting. the upper piece had to go in first.



With it all fitted in and looking good, it was time to weld it in.

I also found some rusted through spots in the rear floor under the seat that will need attention and what better time than NOW to cut out the rust!.



This is the view from the engine compartment showing the back of the package area and the "shelf" in the air handling area under the rear window. Notice the drain hole on the shelf, almost middle page. There is on the other side too. Those are there for a reason. They take a rubber gravity drain and they are usually missing! If yours are missing, you have a huge air leak from the fresh air NOT getting to your engine! Let the welding begin !



I drilled small holes in the rear of the package shelf area to enable me to get the best spot welds on the panel. You can see the holes lined up in the weld through primer.



After about 4.5 hours of welding the firewall and package shelf are welded in. After another 4 hours of fitting the engine compartment pan-
