Richard Law made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Pat Silver seconded the motion. The motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.







Members Tech Corner

Tech Tip for May 2020 By James Ergenbright

Seven is a Good Number!

What started out as a chance to rebuild the Turbo Carburetor for our 1963 Corvair Spyder turned into building 7 Turbo Carburetors during the "Stay at Home" period of the COVID 19 Pandemic. With earlier encouragement through the months from Bob Welch, Richard Law, Pat Silver, Ken Drye and my Brother-in-Law James Cheek, I decided to give it a try.

I had previously purchased the book by Bob Helt, "How To Identify And Rebuild Carter YH Carburetors Used On Corvair Turbocharged Engines",

so with that in hand I worked on the dining room table and started disassembling, cleaning, identifying, and fixing problems discovered in the carburetor. The multiple problems found definitely showed why the 1963 Spyder had been sitting for a number of years. The Carburetor was so out of adjustment and had a worn throttle shaft, it was surprising that it would even start let alone drive down the road. As this was the first time to rebuild a YH Turbo carburetor, I read the book "word for word" and followed each step meticulously. Finally, it was assembled and adjusted, and thus completed, ready to install on the engine. I had acquired a couple more carburetors for our 1965 Corsa, Turbo Engine Replacement project and had purchased some partial carburetors for extra parts, so I decided to rebuild them too. I ordered parts from Clarks and California Corvair, carburetor kits, paint and started the task. It took a couple of months to complete, but now I have completed 2-1963 late model, 1-1964, 3-1965 late model (1 with early needle and jet), and 1-1966 Turbo Carburetors (7 total rebuilds).

It ended up being a bigger project than expected, but what fun it became. I understand now why it cost so much to rebuild them to specifications. The parts cost and time it takes to build them back to specs was surprising.

In the end the challenge was worth it, I would do it again.







Corvair Ladies Shared Recipe Corner

This months recipe shared by Linda DuVall

DISHPAN COOKIES

Ingredients

- 2 Cups light brown sugar
- 1 Cup white sugar
- 2 teaspoons vanilla
- 2 Cups Oil
- 4 eggs
- 4 Cups flour
- 2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 ½ cups quick oats
- 4 Cups cornflakes

Instructions

In a very large bowl or dishpan, cream sugars, vanilla, oil, and eggs. Add flour, soda, and salt. Fold in oats and cornflakes.

Drop by ¼ measuring cup onto ungreased cookie sheets. This batter might be a little dry and you may have to mosh it together with your hands to get it into a ball when you put it onto the pan.

Bake for ten to twelve minutes at 375, or until edges are lightly browned. If you want them to be chewy, bake a little less, crispy, a little more. I always double this recipe and do half chewy, half crunchy. They keep really well and are great for breakfast. *This freezes well both as a dough and as a finished cookie.
